We will work together for the continuance of a faithful evangelical ministry in this church, as we sustain its worship, ordinances, discipline, and doctrines. We will contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expenses of the church, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the gospel to all nations.

We will endeavor to engage our culture for the betterment of our society by:

- taking a pro-life stand for the unborn, the elderly of our society and those too physically ill or handicapped to defend themselves.
- promoting the biblical model of marriage between one man and one woman
- combating the abuse of drugs and the spread of pornography
- abstaining from the abuse of alcohol

We will, unite with some other church where we can carry out the principles of God's word if we move from this place.
